Directions to Foxwoode Hunt Club:

From HWY 23: Take M-59 East to Harvey Lake Rd. After a Michigan left, go north on Harvey Lake Rd. After the blinking red stop, Harvey Lake Rd. becomes Millford Rd. To Chana (a gravel road) and take a right. At the next stop sign, Rose Center Rd. turn right. Foxwoode Hunt Club will be on your right hand side 3/4 of a mile down.

From Pontiac/ West Bloomfield: Take M-59 west to Ormond Rd, turn right. At next stop turn left onto White Lake Rd. Continue on White Lake Rd to the second round-a-bout and follow Rose Center Rd. (gravel road) for 1 mile to Foxwoode Hunt Club on your left.

From Clarkston/I-75: Take Dixie HWY to White Lake Road and go south. At next light after railroad tracks turn right onto Andersonville. At next light turn left onto White Lake Road. Follow White Lake Road for several miles through blinking red light to the second round-a-bout. Follow Rose Center Rd. (gravel road) for 1 mile to Foxwoode Hunt Club on your left.

 2. Open Equitation—Open to all. Fence Height not to exceed 3'3
 3. Open Junior Medal 3'3 - See MHJA rulebook
 4. Open Adult Medal 3'0 - See MHJA rulebook
 5. Jumper Warm up - 2'9. Open to all. Fence height not to exceed 2'9 Table 2
 6. Novice Jumper - Open to all. Fence height not to exceed 2'9. Table 2.2b
 7. Open Jumper - Open to all. Fence height not to exceed 3'3. Table 2.2b
 8. Child/Adult Hunter - Open to riders who have not competed in classes requiring them to jump 3'6 or higher. This class is also open to First Year Green Eligible horse with professionals mounted. Fence Height 3'0
- Schooling Break if Necessary*
9. Child/Adult Hunter
 10. Child/Adult Equitation - not open to professionals
 11. Novice hunter - Open to riders who have not competed at a MHJA or USEF competition jumping 3'3 or higher. Fence Height 2'6-2'9

 14. Limited Junior Medal 3'0 - See MHJA rulebook
 15. Limited Adult Medal 2'9 - See MHJA rulebook
 16. Young Riders Medal - See MHJA rulebook

22. Warm up open thru class 36. Height will change with each division
23. Low Hunter - Open to riders who have not competed a MHJA Regular Member or USEF Recognized horse show where fence heights were 3'0 or higher. Open to Baby Green horses and professional mounts. Fence Height 2'6
24. Low Hunter
25. Low Equitation - not open to professionals
26. Maiden Hunter - Open to riders who have not competed in classes requiring them to jump 2'9. Baby Green horses or horses in their first year of competition are welcome in this division. No in and outs. Fence Height 2'3
27. Maiden Hunter
28. Maiden Equitation
29. MHJA Pony Medal - See MHJA rulebook
30. Intermediate Junior Medal - See MHJA rulebook
31. Beginner Hunter - Open to riders in their first or second year of competition. Short Stirrup and Novice Pony riders may enter this division. No oxer rails or in and outs. Fence Height 2'0
32. Beginner Hunter
33. Beginner Equitation
34. Cross Pole Hunter - Open to riders in their first year of showing. A rider may cross enter into the beginner.
35. Cross Pole Hunter
36. Cross Pole Equitation
37. Ple Pole Hunter - Open to riders in their first year of advanced flat work. Maybe not ready for a course of jumps but building up to it. Riders may only cross enter into Advanced WTC from this division
